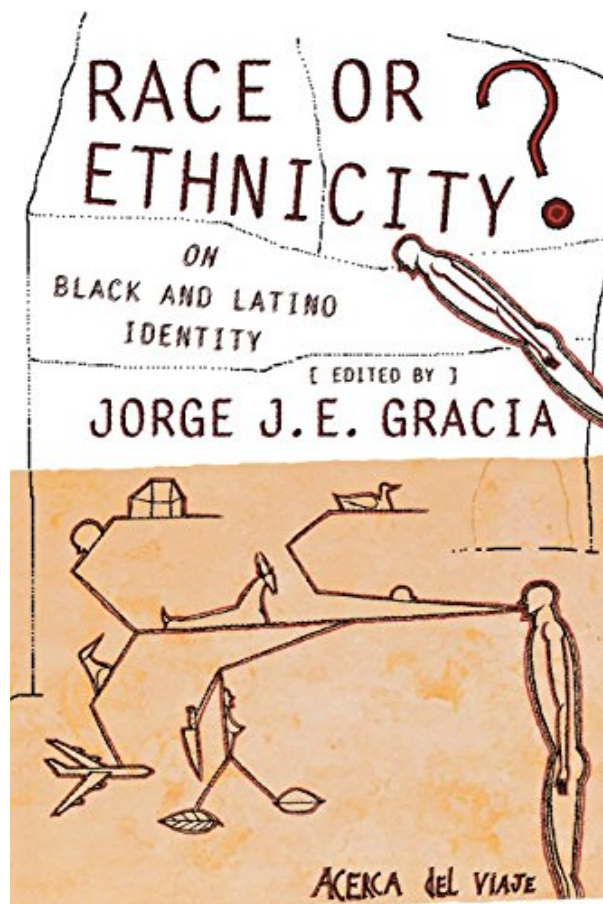
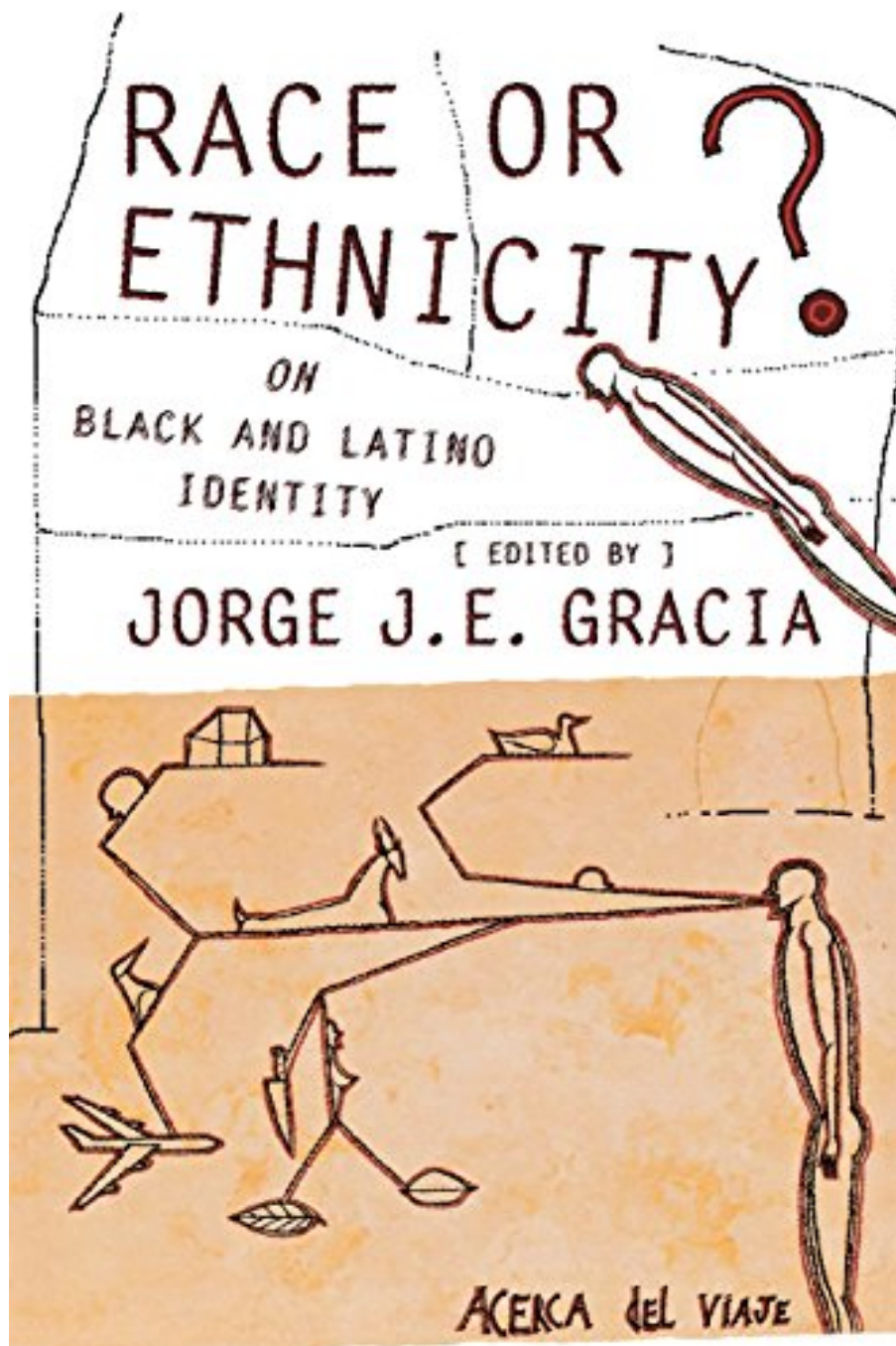

And what is the role of affect in social justice as dispensed by the courts?
